Blessed with a house reef where you can begin your dive only 60 feet from the dive center, Wakatobi is often described as a live aboard with a built-in beach! In addition to the spectacular house reef, there are several dozens of easily accessible dive sites offering incredible marine life diversity, color and natural splendor.

The entire Wakatobi region has been turned into a sustainable protected marine park. The local village and surrounding communities have "bought in" to the conservation plan and as a result, illegal fishing, reef walking and other activities detrimental to the coral reef have been halted. Part of your payment for staying and diving at Wakatobi goes back to the community to sustain and support this new way of living. Living in harmony and in respect of the coral reef ecosystem.



The intimate, eco-friendly resort is situated on a small island locally called Onemobaa. Our island is beside Tomia Island, one of four major islands covering an area of over 300 square miles. The beautiful resort is built directly at the seaside, with all bungalows spaced along our exquisite beach.

Over the years Wakatobi has grown from being a simple, remote outpost to a fully equipped resort offering comforts otherwise not associated with the best diving. Often you have to choose between comforts and diving quality.

All accommodations are spacious and available with either a king-size bed, and/or twin beds to sleep up to three adults or two adults and two children.
