The Graveyard of the Atlantic gets its name from the estimated 2000 shipwreck scattered along the North Carolina coastline. Some of the most impressive wrecks are the World War II



casualties – vessels fallen prey to Hitler's U-boat fleet as they traversed the offshore waters. Tankers, cargo ships, British fishing



travelers and even German submarines, from impressive underwater monuments to this tumultuous segment of our maritime heritage.

The shipwrecks provide a vital habitat for numerous species of fish, coral, and invertebrate marine life. Rays the size of small cars, loggerhead turtles nestled

into the corner of a wreck, octopus, eels, and fish fish fish!

A common occurrence when diving North Carolina is that of a sand tiger shark. An impressive looking but docile shark, often present in large numbers, ranging in size from four to over eight feet long!
